# QUALITY VIDEO PRODUCTION ON A BUDGET



- Horizontal video is the standard for film or TV. Think YouTube
- Social media is the exception to horizontal video rule which is often consumed on mobile phones
- Get stable shots (Sequence: Wide, Medium, Tight)
- Recording
  - Get down on your subjects level
  - Use the exposure lock to control lighting
  - your subject)
  - Audio matters use your microphone for your on-camera portion, voice overs, and any interviews
  - Take advantage of natural light or use a well-lit areas
  - Turn on airplane mode while shooting to avoid interruptions

#### **Voiceover Tips**

- Draft a script. This will assist you in close caption the video
- Write conversationally, avoid "eduspeak"
- voice over
- Record in a quiet space without distractions
